

## Road fear over regeneration

THE city council's transport officials have raised concerns about the massive £200 million regeneration of Craigmillar.

Head of transport Marshall Poulton has written to his counterpart in the planning department, Alan Henderson, to warn of the need for more discussion.

In particular, he said more consideration is needed if Niddrie Mains Road is to be narrowed, and said pedestrian crossings on the street should be controlled, not "courtesy crossings".

The council department said transport assessments may be requested as part of further detailed planning applications.

Community group Craigmillar 1st today called for this to be carried out before the outline planning application is approved.
